This bursary may be presented to 1 or 2 students of Afro-Canadian/African descent.

The Fund was launched in 2007 to commemorate the *Bicentenary of the Abolition of the British Slave Trade Act - 1807.* It was established as a lasting legacy of that occasion, to assist our youth in pursuing post-secondary education in an institution of higher learning, reduce dropout rates from schools, and also to encourage students to return to contribute to the advancement of our community and the country as a whole.



Who is eligible for the Award?

Secondary school students of Afro-Canadian Heritage/African descent who are applying to a post-secondary institution for the current year

Students must demonstrate contribution to school and community life Students must be a resident of Greater Sudbury or North Eastern Ontario Financial need may be considered Scholastic achievement is an asset.

How are recipients selected?

The Selection Committee is made up of an educator, members of the Afro-Heritage Association, members of the participating Afro- Canadian Group of Sudbury, and a member of the Sudbury Community Foundation. The decisions of the Selection Committee will be final. Members of the Selection Committee will be required to declare a conflict of interest agreement if any.

How is the Award presented?

A special ceremony will be held yearly to present the Award. Recipients will receive a personalized certificate. The Award, up to \$3,500, will be forwarded directly to the post-secondary institution for the recipients' respective use.
